## DEPARTMENTS OF MUSIC AND PERFORMING ARTS

For students to be accepted to the Music and Performing Arts Departments, an aptitude test is given in the direction of the exam curriculum on the conservatory web page. The quota is determined by the Higher Education Council and is announced on its page.

The age limit for students to take the entrance exam for the undergraduate degree is 25, and 30 years for the composition and orchestra conductor.

The Music and Performing Arts Departments provide education and research, artistic activities in universal standards and provide the artistic and cultural development of our students so that they can be beneficial to our society and humanity.

The Music and Performing Arts Departments provide training in Turkish. Two semesters are required in composition and opera arts. Education is provided with the semester and course-passing systems at the undergraduate level. An absolute grading system is applied.



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
