

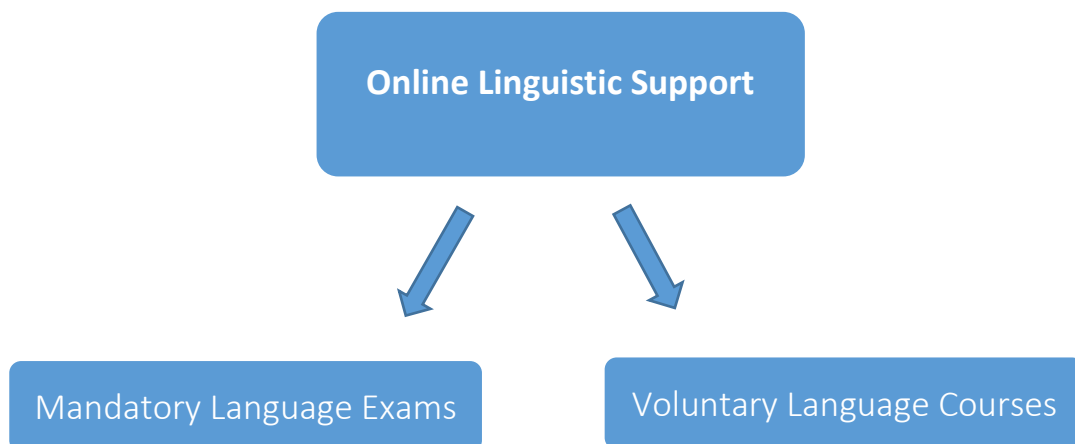
Erasmus + Online Linguistic Support



ONLINE LINGUISTIC SUPPORT (OLS)

What is Online Linguistic Support?

Before and After Erasmus activity, every student to exercise Erasmus activity has to take the online language exam which is sent to their e-mail addresses and submit the results to International Relations Office. Online Linguistic Support includes language exams which the students are supposed to take and online voluntary language course support;



In which Languages is Online Linguistic Support available?

German, French, Dutch, Italian, English and Spanish, Czech, Danish, Greek, Polish, Portuguese and Swedish

Mandatory Language Exams

Before and after activity students nominated for study and traineeship mobility, take exams through Online Linguistic Support in the language in which they complete their study/traineeship activity.

These exams which students are supposed to take before and after activity are MANDATORY.

Even if it is mandatory when students do not take language exam and/or do not submit the results to International Relations Office their grants are cut in accordance with ***Erasmus+ Main Action 1: Mobility of Individuals, Student Mobility and Staff Mobility at Higher Education Between Program Countries - Handbook for Higher Education Institutions Article 8.***

Student is registered in Erasmus+ Online Linguistic Support System when student comes to International Relations Office for outgoing processes.

After registration process, a username and password are given to the student via system.

Student sends exam result to e-mail address erasmus@deu.edu.tr.

Will Exam Result Affect My Erasmus Mobility?

No. Exam results affect student's Erasmus activity by no means. Purpose of OLS exam is to measure the improvement at language level of student before and after mobility.

Voluntary Language Courses

- If the mandatory exam result before mobility is B1 and below B1 level, courses start automatically in exam's language. Student can take courses during Erasmus activity period by logging in system with username and password which were already given before.
- If the mandatory exam result before mobility is B2 and over B2, students can also take online language courses voluntarily. In this situation, student informs International Relations Office about language preference and courses in this language become available for student.
- Voluntary Language Courses are free of charge.
