**CONTRIBUTIONS AND TUITION FEES TO BE RECEIVED AS A STUDENT
CONTRIBUTION TO CURRENT SERVICE COSTS IN HIGHER
EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN THE 2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR
DECISION ON DETERMINATION**

Student contribution and tuition fees of students placed in higher education institutions according to central placement principles

ARTICLE 1- (1) In the 2023-2024 Academic Year, the contribution amounts to be made by the State and the student to the current service costs of higher education institutions in primary and open education are shown in the attached table (I), and the tuition fee amounts of second and distance education students are shown in the attached table (II).

(2) In higher education institutions that teach for two semesters in an academic year, the student contributions and tuition fees to be received for each day are half of the amounts determined in the attached tables.

(3) Without prejudice to the provisions of Articles 3 and 10, no student contribution shall be received from primary and open education students who continue their education in the 2023-2024 Education Year or who will newly enroll. The student contribution amounts to be received from these students are covered by the State. Student contribution amounts to be covered by the State in the 2023-2024 Academic Year within the scope of this paragraph
It is paid with an increase of 40%.

(4) The spouses and children of those who lost their lives while performing their duties within the scope of Article 47 of the Social Insurance and General Health Insurance Law No. 5510 dated 31/5/2006 and Article 47 of the Law No. 2330 dated 3/11/1980 on Cash Compensation and Monthly Connection, the Law No. 2453 dated 23/4/1981 on Granting Cash Compensation and Monthly Connection to Foreign Personnel, the Flight, Parachute, Submarine, Diver and Frogman Services Compensation Law No. 2629 dated 28/2/1982 and the Anti-Terrorism Law No. 3713 dated 12/4/1991; the disabled and their spouses and children within the scope of Law No. 3713 and Law No. 2330; the spouses and children of those who received honorary allowance and their children within the scope of the Law No. 24/2/1968 dated and 1005 on Granting Honorary Allowance to Those Who Were Given the Medal of Independence; without limitation of age, program duration and number of programs registered, student's share/tuition fee is not charged. Students who cannot submit the relevant documents during registration or renewal of registration for the 2023-2024 Academic Year, but within the scope of this article, are refunded from the rejection and refunds item of the student contribution/tuition fees paid for this Academic Year on the date they submit the said documents.

(5) During enrollment or renewal of enrollment in higher education programs, in accordance with the Law on Disabilities dated 1/7/2003 and numbered 5378 and the Regulation on Disability Assessment for Adults dated 20/2/2019 and numbered 30692, the amount of tuition fees to be paid by the students who submit the report that they are disabled to the relevant higher education institution is reduced by the program duration and the disability rate without the number of enrollments. Within the scope of this paragraph, students who continue or newly enrolled in primary education and open education programs shall not be charged a student contribution without limiting the duration of the program and the number of programs enrolled. Students who are disabled but do not submit a report indicating that they are disabled during registration or renewal of registration for the 2023-2024 Academic Year, on the date they submit the relevant document, the amount of the discount to be made from the tuition fees

they have paid for this Academic Year or the amount of the student's multiplied share shall be refunded from the rejection and refunds item.

(6) The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) is the national authority and ÖSYM headquarter

those who are placed in associate degree and undergraduate programs with the placement exam and students who have been placed and completed their undergraduate programs and enrolled in lisnnsiistü education programs are subject to the principles of contribution for primary education and open education and learning fee for secondary education according to the relevance of this Decision in terms of tuition fee.

(7) While dismissed from higher education institutions, the periods to be taken as a basis for the State to meet the student contributions of the students who have the right to continue their education with the legal arrangements made shall be calculated by deducting the periods before the first registration period after the amnesty from the program periods specified in Article 10.

(8) In the event that the student does not renew his/her registration or receives a suspension penalty, the interrupted education periods shall be deemed to have been used from the program poems specified in Article 10,

(9) The periods to be taken as a basis for the State to meet the student contribution shares of the students who obtain the first starting point of their undergraduate education by vertical transfer are calculated by deducting the periods before the period in which they enroll in the undergraduate program from the program periods specified in Article 10.

(10) Within the scope of Erasmus and Mevlana Exchange Programs, students coming from abroad and going abroad are subject to the legislation of their higher education institutions in terms of their obligations regarding contribution and tuition fees.

(11) The Directorate of Strategy and Budget is authorized to determine the procedures and principles for the implementation of this street and to eliminate any hesitations that may arise.

Action to be taken on those who do not pay the contribution and tuition fee on time ARTICLE 2- (1) Student contributions and tuition fees at the beginning of the relevant semester

during registration or registration renewal. Those who do not pay the contribution or tuition fee within the period and whose excuses are not accepted by the administration of the relevant higher education status cannot register for that period and cannot benefit from their student rights.

(2) Those who do not benefit from their student rights due to not registering shall not pay the contribution and tuition fee for the period in which they are not eligible for their student rights if they register in the following semesters.

Tuition fee amounts TO BE collected from students TO BE admitted from abroad

ARTICLE 3- (1) The tuition fee to be charged to students who will enroll within the admission quotas from abroad is determined by higher education institutions, not less than twice the current service cost of the student determined in the attached tables (I) and (II), depending on their interest.

(2) Among the foreign students who will register within the quotas for student admission from abroad, the family of the student and those who have obtained a residence permit in Turkey; In the event that more than one student from the same family continues their education in state higher education institutions, the tuition fees determined for these students are reduced by the relevant higher education status, not

less than 25%.

(3) The tuition fees of Syrian citizens who are hosted in our country due to the events in the Syrian Arab Republic are as much as the current service cost of each program for those who are placed in associate, undergraduate and graduate education institutions within the scope of the admission quotas of students from abroad according to the principles determined by the Council of Higher Education. These amounts are deposited into the account of the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities by the foreign institution that grants the student and transferred to the relevant higher education institution from the budget of the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities on behalf of these students.

(4) Higher education according to the principles determined by the Council of Higher Education and coming from the countries where the Council of Higher Education has signed a cooperative | -, i protocol and/or memorandum of understanding the tuition fee for students placed in the undergraduate or graduate programs of their institution shall be the amounts shown in Schedules (I) and (II) attached to this Decision, as the case may be, as long as they maintain their placement requirements. These amounts are transferred to the relevant higher education institution in lump sum by the Council of Higher Education within the year. Students who are removed from the scope of support due to the transition to the citizenship of the Republic of Turkey are subject to the provisions of Article 1 in terms of learning fee, and those who are removed for other reasons are subject to the provisions of the first paragraph of Article 3.

(5) The tuition fee determined by the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities; the tuition fee of the students who graduated from the high school level educational institutions affiliated to the Ministry of National Education, the Ministry of Religious Affairs of Turkey and the Ministry of Education of Turkey, the international imam hatip high schools that provide education within the scope of the international imam hatip student programs carried out in cooperation with the Ministry of Religious Affairs of Turkey and the Ministry of National Education, and the minority high schools and the e% education institutions in the imam hatip high school statüsü affiliated to Muslim religious administrations and enrolled in associate degree and undergraduate programs within the admission quotas of students from abroad are the amounts shown in the (I) and (II) numbered tables attached to this Decision according to their interest.

(6) The tuition fees to be paid by the students who continue their education in the primary education and open education programs within the scope of the fifth paragraph and who will be newly enrolled are covered from the budget of the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities on behalf of these students. The procedures and principles regarding the implementation are determined jointly by the Presidency of Strategy and Budget, the Presidency of the Council of Higher Education and the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities.

(7) In our country, students who will be admitted to universities from abroad are not charged tuition fees on the basis of reciprocity.

(8) Higher education institutions are authorized to receive less than ten percent of the number of foreign students enrolled in the relevant period (except for foreign students who receive full scholarship from public administrations, institutions and associations established by law, associations that show public interest and foundations that are granted tax exemption and who receive higher education within the quotas allocated by the Council of Higher Education) and with the decision of the board of

directors, in order to increase student mobility from geographies with intense historical and cultural ties, to include successful students abroad in their programs or to encourage students who have superior success in their education.

Using the tuition fee

ARTICLE 4- (1) Ten of the tuition fees to be charged in secondary education are used in accommodation, health, sports, culture and other social services of the students, especially in nutrition. The remaining part is used according to the procedures and principles determined by the Higher Education Council to be included in the university budget.

Learner fee amounts of the students in the top line

5- (1) Secondary education students who are successful in the minimum courses determined for each semester in the program they are in at the end of the year (fall and spring semester) in those who implement an annual education program, except for the preparatory class, and in those who implement a semester program at the end of the relevant semester, and who enter the first ten percent in the ranking to be made as of the end of the semester according to the success average of the students who take these courses;

a) In the next semester in the programs providing semester education-education,
b) In the programs that provide annual education, the student pays a tuition fee equal to the student contribution determined for primary school students in the next academic year.

(2) When students who benefit from Article 7 of the Law No. 3843 dated 19/11/1992 make a lateral transfer to another tertiary education status enjoy the same rights. In this case, students are charged a tuition fee equal to the contribution determined for primary education students for the relevant semester.

Contribution and tuition fee amounts of students who are entitled to study at another higher education institution

ARTICLE 6- (1) Students who settle in another higher education institution according to the result of the exam they re-enter while enrolled in a higher education program are subject to the floor share/tuition fee of the higher education program they will enroll in.

Contribution/tuition fee amounts of students studying for compulsory service and students studying as a State scholarship

ARTICLE 7- (1) All student contributions of students studying in return for compulsory service on behalf of ministries and public institutions shall be paid to the higher education institutions by the relevant Ministry or organization.

(2) Pursuant to the Presidential Decree on the Organization of Relevant, Associated Institutions and Organizations and Other Institutions and Organizations Affiliated to Article 4, the tuition fee for students who come to our country to study abroad in accordance with the principles determined by the Presidency of Turks and Related Communities is 800 TL. This amount is included in the budget of the Presidency for Turks Abroad and Related Communities and transferred to the relevant higher education institution by the Presidency at once during the year.

(3) Students who are removed from the scope of the state scholarship due to the transition to the citizenship of the Republic of Turkey are subject to the provisions of Article 1 from the tuition fee copper, and those who are removed for other reasons are subject to the provisions of the first paragraph of the 3 pioneering articles.

Contribution and tuition fees in higher education institutions whose names have been changed or converted to newly established faculties or schools of higher education and **faculties or schools of higher education**

SIADDE 8- (i) Students studying in higher education institutions whose names are changed by the relevant legislation or transformed into a village or high school are subject to the student contribution/tuition fee related to the higher school where they will be diplotnas.

(2) In the event that faculties and programs not included in the attached tables are established in higher education institutions, Yükseköğretim Kurulu Başkanlığı is authorized to determine the group to which these faculties and programs will be related in the attached tables in relation to student contributions and tuition fees.

Tuition fee and student contribution amounts in higher education programs teaching in a foreign language

öIADDE 9- (1) The tuition fee is one and a half times in jnikseköğretim programs that teach in a foreign language.

Contribution and **tuition fee** amounts of **students who cannot graduate** on time ARTICLE 10- (1) Scientific with preparatory class or foreign language development program

except for the preparatory class, students who cannot graduate at the end of the program periods specified in the Higher Education Institutions Exam (YKS) Higher Education Programs and Quotas Guide from associate and undergraduate level higher education programs, and those who cannot graduate at the end of the program periods specified in the Graduate Education and Training Regulation from graduate level higher education programs are charged a student contribution and tuition fee equal to the amounts specified in the attached tables. The period in which student contributions will be covered by the State in preparatory classes or foreign language development programs and scientific preparatory classes is one year.

(2) The students enrolled in the double major program receive the learning poem of the diploma program and the student contribution from the students who cannot graduate at the end of an additional year.

(3) The student contribution of only one program in which the student is enrolled is covered by the State. If the state higher education institution is enrolled in a higher education program while enrolled in a second higher education program (except for double major programs), the student contribution shares of the second program are covered by the students themselves.

Tuition fee amounts of research assistants

ARTICLE 11- (1) Research assistants who have graduate education in secondary education pay a tuition fee in the amount of the contribution.

(2) The provision of the first paragraph of Article 10 shall not apply to the postgraduate education of research assistants working in state higher education institutions and receiving postgraduate education in primary education.

amounts to be paid in case of closure of these secondary education program or transfer of students to the primary education program

ARTICLE 12- (1) Existing students transferred to the primary education program due to the cancellation of the secondary education program in accordance with Article 4 of the Law No. 3843 shall be subject to the first tier %production

contribution principles.

(2) Students studying in secondary education programs whose number of students is ten or less are transferred to the primary education program upon the request of the university and the approval of the Yl \times sel cğretim Kurulu and these students are subject to the principles of ICT education contribution.

Contribution and tuition fee amounts of transients

ARTICLE 13- (1) Students who have completed their undergraduate education in a university in Turkey by transferring from the higher education institution in foreign countries or studying abroad to State higher education institutions and who are decided to complete their undergraduate education in a university in Turkey and placed in higher education institutions shall be subject to the principles of contribution for primary education and tuition fee for secondary education, without prejudice to the provisions of Article 3.

(2) Students who transfer from primary education programs to secondary education programs in accordance with the undergraduate transfer conditions pay a tuition fee. According to Article 6 of the Law No. 3843, students who transfer from the second education programs to the first education program are subject to the principles regarding the student contribution of the program they transfer to.

(3) In case of lateral transfer, the contribution/tuition fee for the relevant period is paid to the higher education institution to which the transfer is made.

(4) The tuition fee amounts paid by the undergraduate transfer students for the relevant period before the transfer are returned to the relevant persons from the rejection and refunds plenary, regardless of whether they are requested or not.

Health expenses of state scholarship students

ARTICLE 14- (1) Pursuant to the Presidential Decree No. 4, the general health insurance premiums to be paid in accordance with the seventh paragraph of Article 60 of the Law No. 5510 for students coming to our country to study abroad in accordance with the principles determined by the Presidency of Foreign Turks and Related Communities, for this purpose, from the appropriation allocated in the budget of the Presidency of Foreign Turks and Related Communities.

Actions TO BE taken IN case OF deregistration

ARTICLE 15- (1) The contribution pays and tl fees of the students who voluntarily cancel their registration shall not be reimbursed.

Teachers with postgraduate education

ARTICLE 16- (1) Graduate students benefit from the rights and services offered to associate and undergraduate students in the same way.

(2) The tuition fee to be charged to postgraduate students within the scope of distance education is subject to the tuition fee of non-thesis higher lisms programs.

No other fees

ARTICLE 17- (1) Students are not charged under any name for the contribution/tuition fee (except for the open education and distance education material fee) during the new registration and registration renewal.

Students not included IN the scope OF the decision

ARTICLE 18- (1) This Decision shall not be applied to students who are placed in higher education institutions according to the principles determined by the Council

of Higher Education, while they are registered in foundation higher education institutions closed by the Statutory Decree on the Measures Taken within the Scope of the State of Emergency dated 22/7/2016 and numbered 667.

Communiqué ON implementation

ARTICLE 19- (1) The Presidency of Strategy and Strategy may issue communiqués by taking the opinion of the Board of Higher Education in liusus related to the implementation of this Decision.

PROVISIONAL ARTICLEI- (1) Within the scope of the quotas for student admission from abroad; the amount of tuition fee to be collected from the students who enrolled in tince in the 2014-2015 academic **year** and continued their education within the program period, the current service cost shown in the attached tables of the relevant program, the amount of tuition fee to be received from the students who enrolled in ten undergraduate and undergraduate programs before the 2019-2020 academic year and continued their education within the program period shall be determined by the higher education institutions in a way that shall not exceed five times the current service cost shown in the attached tables of the relevant program. In addition, the amount of the tuition fee to be charged to students who enrolled before the 1023-2024 academic year and continued their education within the program year is not less than one and a half times the current service cost shown in the attached schedules of the relevant program, the amount of the tuition fee to be charged to students who enrolled before the 2021-2022 academic year and continued their education within the program period is not less than the amount of the student contribution share and tuition fee shown in the attached schedules of the relevant program, the amount of the tuition fee to be charged to students who enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year and continued their education within the program period is not less than the amount of the percentage pay and tuition fee shown in the attached schedules of the relevant program. The provision of the fifth paragraph of Article 1 regarding the reduction in the rate of disability shall also apply to students who fall within the scope of this idea.

(2) The scholarships of Syrian citizens hosted in our country due to the events in the Syrian Arab Republic are subject to the principles determined by the Higher Education Kuiuulu, except for those made by the dormitory institutions, within the scope of the student enrollment quotas from the dormitory before the 2021-2022 academic year, the students who were admitted to the higher education institutions at the associate, undergraduate and graduate levels and the students who were enrolled in the higher education institutions before the 2021-2022 academic year, and the students who were enrolled in the higher education institutions within the scope of the principles determined by the Higher Education Council within the scope of the (B) section of the Principles Regarding the Admission of Foreign Students within the scope of subparagraphs (2) and (4) of Article (a), and within the scope of the quotas, the provisions of the first paragraph of Article 3 shall not apply to persons placed in the higher education institutions before the 2021-2022 academic year. In terms of tuition fees, these students are subject to the principles of contribution for primary education and open education and learning fee for secondary education according to the relevance of this Decision.

(3) The tuition fees to be paid by the students who continue their education in the primary education and open education programs within the scope of the second paragraph shall continue to be covered in the budget of the Presidency of Turks and Related Communities Abroad on behalf of these students. The procedures and principles regarding the implementation are determined jointly by

the Presidency of Strategy and Budget, the Presidency of the Council of Higher Education and the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities.

Enforcement

ARTICLE 20- (1) This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its publication with effect from 30/6/2023.

Application

ARTICLE 21- (1) The provisions of this Decision shall be enforced by the President of the Republic.
