	USEFUL INFORMATION FOR INCOMING STUDENTS
Orientation Program	Erasmus+ incoming student orientation program, generally organized within the first week of semester. Orientation includes information about Turkish Culture and History, Dokuz Eylül University and its' campuses, practical information about the city, detailed information about residence permit, discounted transportation card for students and our ESN team.
Turkish Language Course	We offer Turkish Language Course to all Erasmus+ Exchange Students, free of charge, every Friday during one semester. Students acquire 3 ECTS credits and a certificate at the end of the course if they get 70 out of 100 on the final exam.

Residence Permit	All international students in Türkiye are required to obtain a student residence permit during their period of study. "Short Term Residence Permit" is a document that you must obtain showing you have entered our country legally and do not have another legal right (international protection applicant/status holder, temporary protection holder/work permit holder, etc.) to stay in our country.

Arrival Dates	1 week or at least 1-2 days before the semester starts.
Insurance	contracted branch in Türkiye.  With some countries, Türkiye has bilateral social security agreement. The students from those countries can benefit from General Turkish Health Insurance without any fees. Students have to bring the original "Medical Assistance Entitlement Certificate" with them and present it to the Social Security Directorate in Izmir. The Social Security Directorate/Center will issue an approved insurance document to the student. Please do check with your home institution if you have a Bilateral Social Security Agreement with Türkiye in case you would like to use it.  You can get private health insurance upon your arrival here in Türkiye.
Health	Those who have Turkish citizenship (dual nationality) or Blue Card from Germany do not need to apply for residence permit.  If you buy private health insurance from abroad, the same company must have a
